



## LA CASA DE ESTUDILLO, OLD TOWN STATE HISTORIC PARK, SAN DIEGO Hazel Waterman exhibit and building signage

*La Casa de Estudillo* is significant as an original building (began in 1827) in an early village for the first permanent European settlement on the west coast of the US. It is also significant as one of the earliest examples of US heritage tourism. We are working with CSP to create an outdoor exhibit focused on the 1850–1920 period. Opening 2011.

Artefact Design: ADA site assessment, interpretive planning, exhibit design, graphic design, fabrication coordination and installation (TBD). Budget: \$150K
