The restored ranch stable is now a classroom, event space and home to the Bunkroom exhibit. The stable and its 350 sq. ft. bunkroom presents Leo Carrillo's work as an authentic rancher, his California heritage as steward of California's land and culture, and a California ambassador in cultural preservation.

The bunkroom served as the sleeping quarters for vaqueros and special guests, and as Leo's office. The exhibit interprets ranching, and Leo's participation in cultural society, through exhibit experiences, visitor interactives and programs.
