Artefact Design (contracted to ABC, Construction, Inc) was asked to refresh existing exhibits and to enhance the overall visitor experience at the San Elijo Lagoon Nature Center. We worked with staff to assess and identify relevant exhibits and to determine new exhibit possibilities.

The Artefact team developed the exhibit Big Idea around the rhythms in nature. Rhythms are an important aspect of introducing, experiencing and understanding nature. They are multi-sensory and seasonal.

By being aware of rhythms, we can know more about the reserve’s habitats, the flora and fauna, and the geography of the region. Rhythms help us improve the conditions that harm the reserve and introduce ways in which each of us, individually and together, can meet the challenges faced by the reserve and its inhabitants. The new interactive exhibits, sensory experiences, and content reflect the goal of creating a more friendly, informative nature experience. Completed March 2017
